1. Discuss this statement: “Those who get grace the most befriend the vulnerable and those who befriend the vulnerable get grace the most.”
2. What are some ways that Boaz prefigures Christ's ministry of justice to the widow, orphan, immigrant, and the poor?
3. How does Boaz' ancestry make his interest in Ruth's welfare especially compelling?
4. David and Robert pointed out that Boaz saw Ruth and her need of justice because God saw Ruth and her need of justice. In what specific ways do you "see" and care for the downcast as God's agent of justice?
5. Do you see yourselves as you truly are before God, as strangers, orphans, widows, and morally bankrupt?
6. Where have you seen justice being practiced in a gospel-way?
7. What is one step toward gospel justice that you can take in the next 3 months?
