





1. What do you do when something seems too good to be true?

3. Which of God's promises sound too good to be true?
4. The Queen of Sheba was open to being wrong, open to learning more, and wanted to know what's true. What makes having this kind of healthy skepticism difficult?
5. The church is not a place where you come to pretend you believe the right answers, but a place where you come to ask all your best questions. How have you experienced this to be true?
6. We come to see the goodness of God through reading the Bible and prayer. How have you experienced this to be true?
7. Share examples of how you have walked away believing, worshiping, and blessed after seeing the greatness of God for yourself.
