

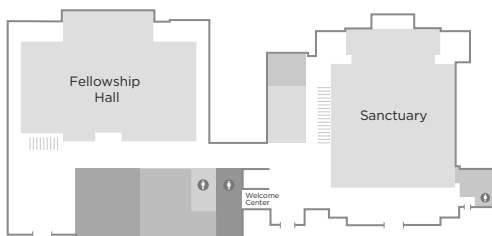

## CONFESSION OF SIN
